DECODE (Develop Competences in Digital Era) is an Erasmus+ funded project which explores the digital skills needed by education professionals as technology becomes more commonplace in the classroom.



The **project's main objective** is to contribute to the improvement of schools' digitisation processes. As well as several research reports, the project will develop a number of training resources for education professionals.

The **DECODE Consortium** is composed of seven partners from five European countries: Italy, Finland, Romania, Spain, and the United Kingdom.


